
1. Reference (a) defines the processes and procedures for accomplishing modernization actions for Submarines, Surface Ships and Carriers. Shore facilities and auxiliary craft will continue to use reference (b) until that time when their procedures are incorporated into reference (a) via an Advance Change Notice (ACN) later this year.

2. Revision 3 incorporates major changes such as renaming the manual, adding the submarine force modernization process and a new appendix for non-permanent changes, and updating business processes, policies, and responsibilities.

3. The Deputy Commander for Nuclear Propulsion, NAVSEA 08, is responsible for all technical matters pertaining to nuclear propulsion of US Navy ship and craft, including all aspects of integration of the nuclear plant into the ship system. Nothing in reference (a) detracts in any way from these responsibilities. Accordingly, NAVSEA 08 will be consulted in all matters relating to or affecting the nuclear propulsion plant and associated nuclear support facilities. In addition, the procedures and requirements in this manual are not applicable to alterations under the cognizance of NAVSEA 08. Strategic Systems Program Alterations (SPALTs) affecting the configuration and/or capabilities of systems and equipment are under the cognizance of the Director, Strategic Systems Programs (DIRSSP). Alterations affecting configuration of firmware and support equipment of the TRIDENT System (including the SSBN 726 Class submarines) are under the cognizance of NAVSEA PMS392 and are exempt from this manual.

4. Revision 3 to reference (a) is approved and is effective this date for all Submarines, Surface Ships, and Carriers. It is posted on the FMP Website at the URL address [www.fmp.navy.mil](http://www.fmp.navy.mil).
